The Lord is risen; it is true! Proclaim it to the world! Pray for an increase to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life.

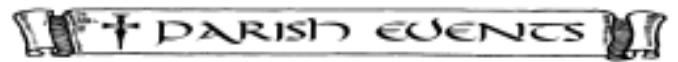
