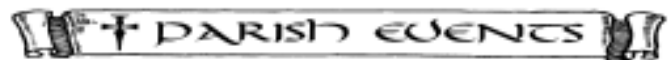

If made a law, virtually all limitations on abortion will be lifted and will affect many standing laws that currently go towards protecting the unborn. The ramifications could even affect the Catholic hospital systems as they would be forced to perform abortions. Beginning this Sunday, begin a rosary novena for the defeat of this bill.
