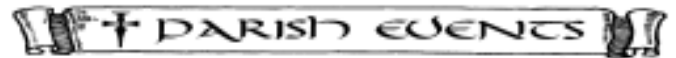

THE DIOCESE OF CHARLESTON HAS A NEW BISHOP! Pope Benedict XVI has appointed Monsignor Robert E. Guglielmone as the 13th Bishop of the Diocese of Charleston. Bishop-elect Guglielmone, is a native of New York and was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Rockville Center on 8 April 1978. Bishop-elect Guglielmone has been involved in the spiritual care of the youth in his priesthood. In addition to teaching high school, he has been involved in Scouting since 1974. He has held local, regional, national and international leadership positions in scouting, including National and World Chaplain as appointed by the Vatican.

Bishop-elect Guglielmone will be ordained and installed at Bishop of Charleston at 7:00 PM on 25 March 2009.
