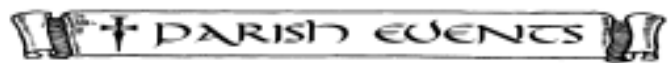

Lenten Regulations 2009

Each year the holy season of Lent provides us a special time of grace and spiritual renewal so that we may become better instruments in sharing the Gospel message.

This year, ASH WEDNESDAY, the beginning of Lent, falls on February 25, 2009. The present laws of the Church regarding fast and abstinence during the Season of Lent are as follows:

1. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast. On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two lesser meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. Catholics who have completed their 18th year are bound by this law until the beginning of their 60th year.

2. Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence. On days of abstinence, meats should not be taken at any meal. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics who have completed their 14th year.

The Obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially," the penitential days specified by the Church is a serious obligation. May this Holy Lenten season provide us an opportunity for deepening of our faith.

World Wide Marriage Encounter will offer a one day parish enrichment at Our Lady of the Rosary on Saturday, March 28th from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. The topic of the seminar is "*Marriage - A Lifetime of Learning*." Mark your calendars now for this wonderful opportunity to enrich your marriage. The cost is \$25 per couple. Are you looking for something special to do during Lent? 40 Days for Life, a coordinated Pro-Life mobilization, will take place from February 25 (Ash Wednesday) through April 5 (Palm Sunday). It focuses on 40 days of prayer and fasting, 40 days of peaceful vigil, and 40 days of community outreach. Our parish is going to focus on the most visible component, peaceful prayer and vigil outside the local abortion facility; we will pray at the Greenville Women's Clinic, 1142 Grove Road. Many churches will come together and pray continuously for 40 days. OLR has the time slot of Sunday, 7 PM to Monday, 7 PM, each week (starting March 1 & 2 and ending March 29 & 30).
