## Kindergarten Supply List

Learning to share is a major objective in the Kindergarten classroom. Some of our supplies will need to be labeled with your child's name. Some will not. This has worked very well in the past. Sharing supplies helps us to get organized quickly and builds community in our classroom. Containers of supplies will be at each table for the kindergarteners to use. I teach the children about caring for the supplies so they are kept in good condition. I am asking for many supplies now and hopefully will not be asking later in the year. You can usually get better deals on the supplies in late summer. Please bring the supplies to school on Monday, August 18<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am (Kindergarten Drop-In for Doughnuts).

### Supplies to be labeled and put in a large soft pencil bag:

- 1 box of Washable Crayola markers
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 pair of Fiskar metal scissors (pointed tips not blunt)

### Supplies to be labeled:

- Back pack (at least 12" wide and 14" tall)
- Lunch box &/or snack bag
- Art smock (or old shirt)
- Large soft pencil bag

### Must be purchased at school and labeled:

- Nap mat (approx. cost \$25.00) available at the Drop-In for Doughnuts
- Class t-shirt (approx. cost \$10.00) to be ordered at Drop-In for Doughnuts

### These supplies do not need to be labeled. Please bring them to the Kindergarten Drop-In for Doughnuts on August 18th.
